TERMS OF OFFICE FOR STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE

A student elected to the Board must be in good standing for a period consistent with the appointment. Good standing is defined as having a minimum course load of 60% with no severe academic sanctions, enrolment restrictions, conduct sanctions, or outstanding fees and/or fines. If an elected student fails to maintain 'good standing', the position will be declared vacant, triggering a by-election.

1.00 POLICY STATEMENTS

- 1.01 The intent of the Board, through this policy, is to establish specific terms of office for Student Representatives to the College Board.
- 1.02 Through annual Student elections, two students shall be elected from the Student body to serve on the College Board.
- 1.03 Alternates may be named when an elected/appointed participant is unable to attend the Board meeting.
- 1.04 Students are elected/appointed for a one -year term, from October 1 through to September 30.
- 1.05 All policies and bylaws that govern the Board shall apply equally to student representatives in the same manner as other members of the Board.
- 1.06 Student members are full members of the board with rights to participate in all board activities, including moving motions and voting; except where there is a potential or real conflict of interest.
